Tips for completing the online booking form

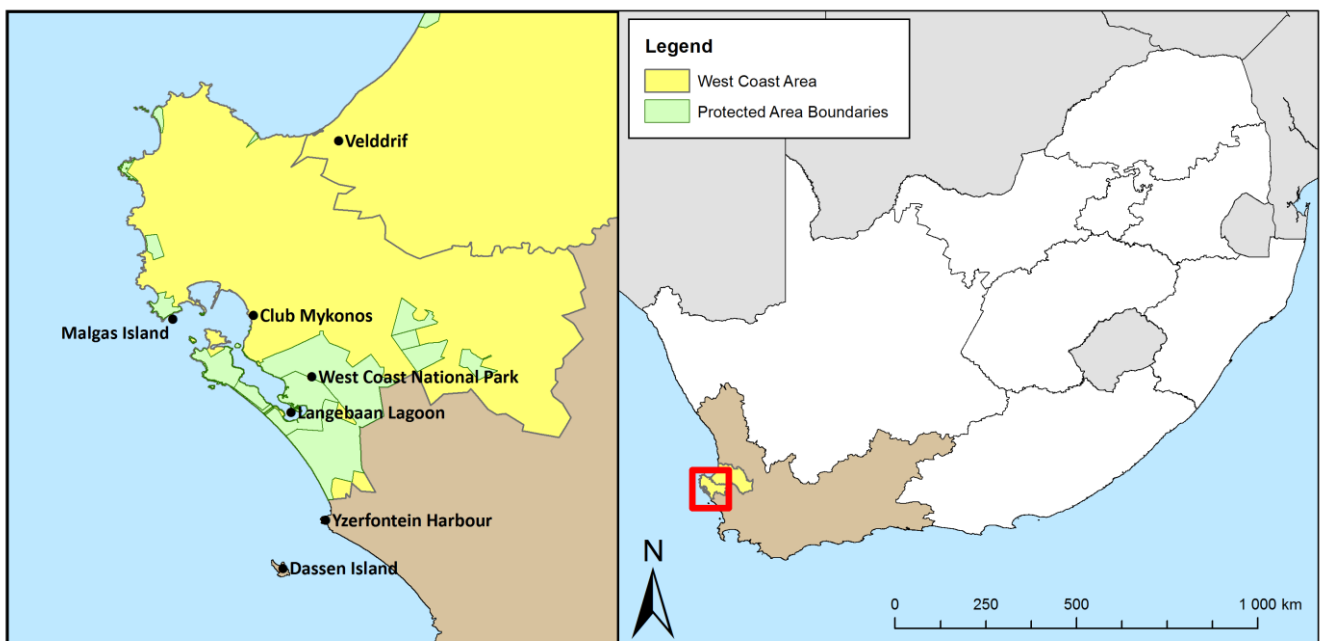
To register for Flock on the West Coast 2018 please follow the link on the Flock [website](#). Bookings can be made for a maximum of two people per submission. The form for Guest One will appear first and if the option to book for two guests is selected, the form for Guest Two will appear at the bottom of the page.

In order to qualify to book for the excursions, Guest One needs to register for either the LAB Conference, BirdLife South Africa AGM, or both.

You will need to agree to the Terms and Conditions before you can submit your booking.

Flock on the West Coast 2018 (Flock 2018) will take place from 6-11 March 2018 at Club Mykonos, Langebaan, Western Cape, South Africa.

LAB Conference Speakers

The 4th bi-annual Learn About Birds (LAB) Conference promises to deliver two days of interesting presentations on the latest bird-related research and conservation efforts taking place in South Africa and abroad. The Science and Layman's LABs will run in parallel and registered delegates are welcome to attend either session.

Plenary speakers at the Science LAB Conference will be Dr Alan Lee (FitzPatrick Institute of African Ornithology, UCT) and Dr Mark Brown (Nature's Valley Trust).

Layman's LAB speakers will present popular interest talks a range of bird and conservation related topics, including an Introduction to the Cape endemic birds (Etienne Marais), Black Harriers of the West Coast National Park (Rob Simmons), and the history and ecology of Dassen Island (Kevin Shaw) to name but a few.

BirdLife South Africa's 89th AGM and final dinner

The BirdLife South Africa AGM will take place in the Athena Hall of Club Mykonos at 14:00 for 14:30 on 10 March 2018. This will be followed by a beach party at Marc's Beach Bar starting from 18:00 onwards. Delegates wishing to attend the AGM and final dinner must book via the online booking form. The cost to attend these events will be R 280 per person.
