A beautiful coffee-table book **Marion & Prince Edward: Africa's Southern Islands**

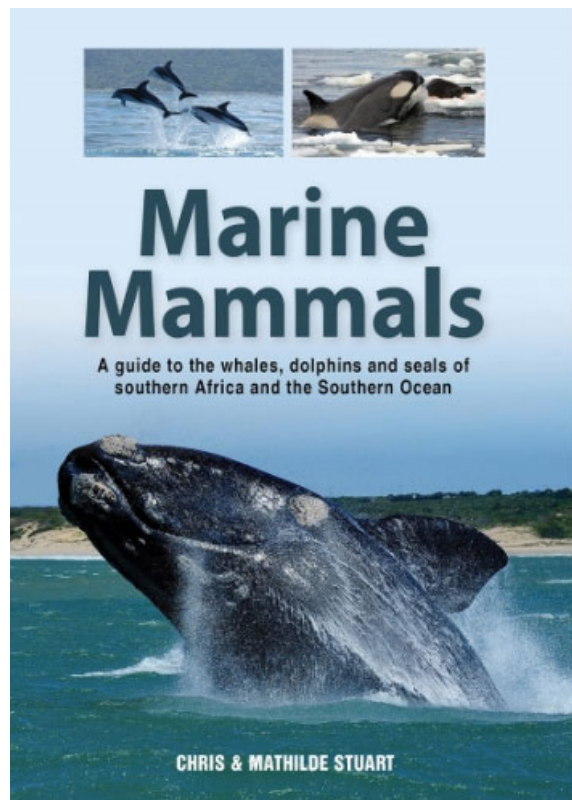
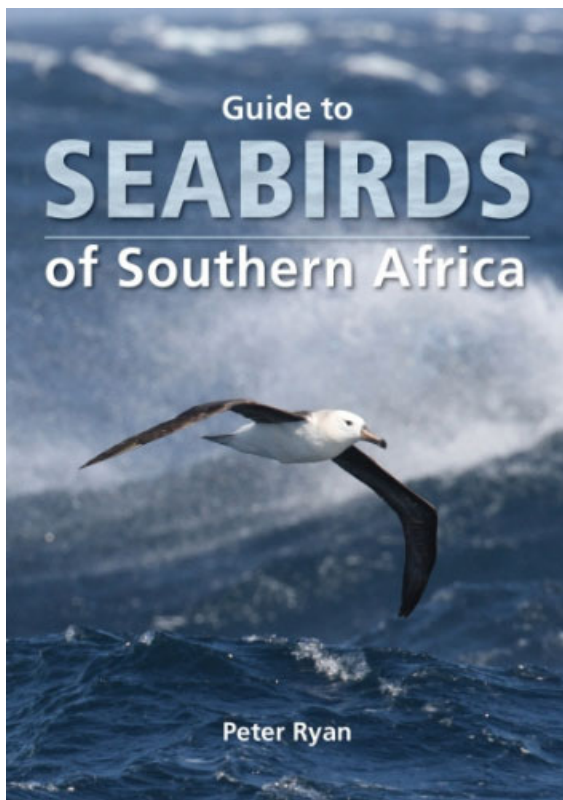
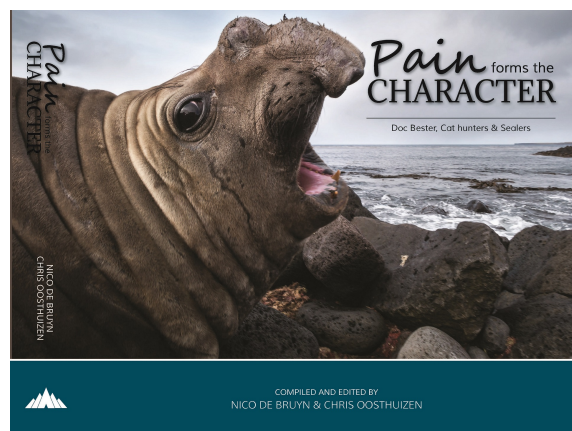
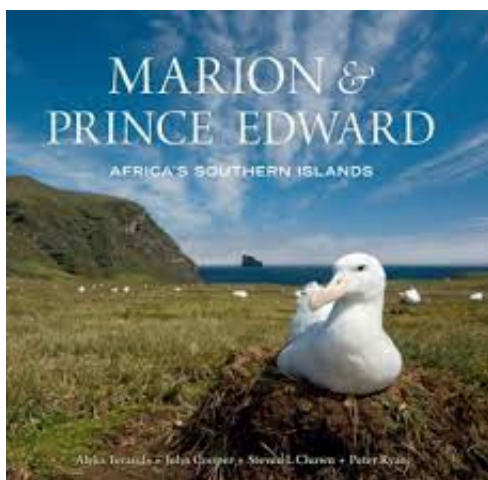

It is a valuable record of the material and social life of a subantarctic community.
