



BirdLife South Africa Photography Competition 2023

TERMS & CONDITIONS

This document provides the Terms & Conditions which apply to BirdLife South Africa's Photography Competition 2023. Please read them in full and confirm that you have read and understood them by checking the mandatory checkbox on the entry form on the competition website (<https://www.birdlife.org.za/photography-competition-2023/>).

The promoter of this competition is BirdLife South Africa, non-profit registration number 001-298 NPO ("the Promoter"), whose registered address is Isdell House, 17 Hume Road, Dunkeld West, 2196 Gauteng.

ELIGIBILITY

The competition is only open to people who are resident in South Africa, and prize winners may be asked to provide necessary supporting documentation.

The competition is not open to BirdLife South Africa employees, BirdLife South Africa Board members, Trustees of the BirdLife National Trust, members of official BirdLife South Africa committees, employees of the competition's sponsors, competition judges, or the immediate families of the aforementioned parties.

ACCEPTANCE

By entering the competition all participants and winners agree to be bound by these terms and conditions, which will be interpreted by the Promoter, in its sole discretion, and its decision regarding any dispute will be conclusive, final and binding and will not be challenged on any grounds, including without limitation, the grounds that the Promoter failed to act reasonably, fairly, in good faith or otherwise in accordance with the principles or procedural fairness.

BirdLife South Africa reserves the right to amend the validity dates of this competition at any time.

To enter the competition, all entrants must comply with the competition by submitting the details as requested. Entries will be considered incomplete and thus disqualified if the entrant does not provide all requested information.

Entry and payment may only be via the Photography Competition page (<https://www.birdlife.org.za/photography-competition-2023>) on the BirdLife South Africa website and its chosen payment mechanism (PayFast) to ensure accurate tracking of entries. No other forms of entry or payment will be allowed.

COMPETITION PERIOD

The competition opens for entries at 06h00 (SAST) on 1 March 2023, and closes for entries at 23h59 (SAST) on 31 May 2023, with judging taking place during the course of June and July 2023.

Any entries received after 23h59 on 31 May 2023 will be invalid and will not be entered into the competition.

ENTRY

To enter this competition, entrants need to complete the entry form on the BirdLife South Africa Photography Competition website (<https://www.birdlife.org.za/photography-competition-2023>), upload their images, accept these Terms & Conditions, and complete payment.

A maximum of four (4) images may be uploaded per entry. Participants may enter more than once, but will have to pay per entry.

Images must have been photographed by and belong to the person entering the competition and whose name is on the entry form. Entrants must be able to supply RAW or hi-res original files if requested. Any persons who infringe on the copyright of another person will be disqualified from the competition, and further action may be taken against them.

Photographers' names and/or watermarks must not be visible on the images that are uploaded to the competition's entry form, so that entries are kept anonymous, for judging purposes. Photographs that are uploaded and display the photographer's name or watermark will be disqualified from the competition, and will not be judged, and entrants will forfeit their entry fee.

Entry fees are R100 (for BirdLife South Africa members) or R300 (for non-BirdLife South Africa members) per entry. For each entry, a maximum of four photographs may be entered into the competition. There is no limit on the number of entries.

The R100 discounted entry fee only applies to fully paid-up members (not *African Birdlife* magazine subscribers, bird club members, or members of the BirdLife South Africa Facebook page or group). Members must be paid up until the end of June 2023 in order to qualify for the discount. Members who enter but are not paid up until the end of June 2023, or who do not renew their membership until then, will forfeit their entry fee.

Entries should be photographs of wild birds that occur in South Africa only. Please refer to the BirdLife South Africa [Checklist of Birds in South Africa 2023](#).

Entrants should follow BirdLife South Africa's [Birding Code of Ethics](#), including no flushing of birds, and avoiding playback of calls to attract birds.

Edits, such as cropping, lighting, etc., should be kept to a minimum, and major manipulation using design software is discouraged.

The entry may not have been an overall or category winner, or runner up, in a previous competition.

SELECTION OF WINNERS

The winners of the following categories will be chosen by a judging panel appointed by BirdLife South Africa: Grand Prize; Action; Portrait; Birds in the Environment; Garden; Youth; Threatened Species; Endemic Species. The winning photographs of these categories will ultimately be chosen according to the judges' discretion, but a number of factors and photographic principles will be judged, including but not limited to: composition, focus, rule of thirds, emotive value, uniqueness of photograph, judges' experience, etc.

The winner of the People's Choice category will be determined by a count of public votes on the BirdLife South Africa website. The judging panel will select a shortlist of photographs that will be eligible for voting, and will be displayed on the Photography Competition web page. Participants will have the chance to share the link with their networks in order to encourage votes on their entry. The prize will be awarded to the shortlisted photograph that receives the most votes according to the voting software.

The winner of the Voter's Prize will be automatically and randomly chosen using automated randomizer software. Voters will be required to submit their name and/or email address, and may only vote once, and for one image.

Please note that no correspondence regarding the competition, or the outcome of the competition, shall be entered into between competition participants and judges during the duration of the competition period (March – July 2023).

The judges' decisions regarding winners are final, and no correspondence with participants or winners will be entered into. No reviews or appeals will be accepted regarding judges' decisions.

WINNER ANNOUNCEMENT & NOTIFICATION

Winners of all categories will be announced at BirdLife South Africa's African Bird Fair on 22 July 2023.

Winners will be notified either telephonically or via e-mail within one week of the winners' announcement, on the cell phone number or e-mail address they supplied when entering this competition.

The competition winners will have five (5) working days to claim acceptance of their prizes, and supply BirdLife South Africa with copies of their South African Identity Documents (IDs). Upon failure to do so, BirdLife South Africa reserves the right to award a new winner, in accordance with the terms stipulated herein.

The decisions of the Promoter and its judging panel are final and the Promoter shall not enter into any correspondence about the results.

Entries that do not comply with these terms and conditions will be disqualified.

The Promoter shall not be liable for any disruption to the competition, whether due to technical problems or otherwise, which is beyond its reasonable control. In the event of any disruption to the competition, the Promoter shall use its reasonable endeavours to remedy any disruption and resume the competition on a fair and equitable basis to the entrants.

By entering the competition, entrants warrant that all information submitted by them is true, current, and complete.

PERSONAL DATA

Completion of a contact form is required for competition entry. The data entered into the form by the entrant is only collected, processed and used by BirdLife South Africa in order to administer the competition.

The Promoter keeps the data to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected or as required by applicable laws or regulations.

OWNERSHIP AND PUBLICITY

BirdLife South Africa reserves the right to publish the names and photographs of the winners, including in its print and digital publication, *African Birdlife* magazine.

Therefore, entrants understand and agree that their submission may be posted and publicly viewable.

By providing a submission, you grant the Promoter the right, except where prohibited by law, to use your name for competition purposes in promoting or publicising the competition, including the right to name the winners of the prizes in public.

Details of the winners may also be announced on the Promoter's website and any other media properties that it chooses. The Promoter, acting reasonably, retains the right to delay the timing of the publication of the winners of the competition.

BirdLife South Africa often has need for photographs of South African bird species in its education, awareness and conservation work. If entrants are willing to allow BirdLife South Africa to use their images for such non-commercial purposes, with credit to the photographer, please tick the relevant box on the entry form.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY

The Promoter reserves the right to terminate the competition at any time.

The Promoter cannot accept any responsibility for entries not received because they have been lost, or not received due to interrupted internet connections or miscommunications, or other electronic malfunctions.

Any entries found to be fraudulent will result in the entrant being excluded from the competition.

By participating, all entrants release the Promoter, its affiliates, partners, subsidiaries, officers, directors, agents, employees and all entities associated with the development and execution of this competition from any and all liability with respect to and in any way arising from participation in this competition, acceptance or use of the prizes.
