BirdLife South Africa will host a series of 'Avitourism Educationals', guided experienced led by experienced birders for tourism service providers to become more acquainted with their local birds and birding sites.

As an attendee, your participation in this/these event/s is based on and subject to the following terms and conditions:

- A registration will only be considered as confirmed once completed on the system and the booking confirmation email is issued.
- Unless otherwise specified, transport costs will not be covered.
- Registrations are only transferable with BirdLife South Africa's agreement.
- Participation in and admittance to the Avitourism Educationals is at each participant own risk. BirdLife South Africa, In Toto Retreat, and the Western Cape Department of Economic Development and Tourism will not be held liable for any losses or damages suffered during the event.
